

Free Water Saving Products – Limited Time Offer

Rules and Eligibility

- Only homeowners in the Thornton water service area are eligible to enter.
- Homeowners with delinquent water accounts are not eligible for this offer.
- Limit one entry form per household.
- Applicants will be entered into a random drawing for FREE water saving products. Applicants must indicate the products they are interested in receiving. Installation address must be in the Thornton water service area.
 - a. Glacier Bay Dual Flush WaterSense 1.28 gallon per flush Toilet – Installation NOT included.
 - b. Rainbird WR2 Rain Sensor to use with existing irrigation controller – Installation included.
 - c. Weather-Based Irrigation Controller with Rain Sensor – Installation included.
- Quantities are limited. Submitting an entry does not guarantee selection in the random drawing.
- Entry must be received by the City of Thornton by 5 p.m. on **September 30, 2010**. Applicants may:
 - a. Mail entry form to City of Thornton Water Resources, **9500 Civic Center Drive, Thornton, CO 80229**.
(Entry form must be mailed in separately from utility bill payment.)
 - b. Enter online at www.ThorntonWater.com or www.cityofthornton.net.
 - c. Call 720-977-6600 to enter by phone.
- Only complete, legible entries will be accepted.
- Selected entries will be notified by e-mail, phone or mail the week of October 4, 2010.
- Toilet recipients:
 - a. Homeowner or designee must be available to pick up toilet at The Home Depot, 10003 Grant Street, Thornton, CO, 80229 on **October 16, 2010**.
 - b. Toilet must be installed by **November 30, 2010**.
 - c. Homeowner must agree to complete a water conservation survey and/or allow City staff to perform an installation inspection.
 - d. City staff will provide you with a receipt when you pick up your toilet. If you are not satisfied with the product, The Home Depot will honor the receipt for a credit of the City's purchase price toward a different model EPA WaterSense labeled toilet.
- Weather-Based Irrigation Controller with Rain Sensor or Rainbird WR2 Rain Sensor applicants:
 - a. Only homeowners with existing underground sprinkler systems may apply for these products.
 - b. Homeowner must be present for the installation of the product in **October 2010**. The Center for ReSource Conservation staff will call the homeowner to schedule an installation appointment.
 - c. To keep your existing controller and add a rain sensor, select the Rainbird WR2 Rain Sensor (not the Weather-Based Irrigation Controller) on the entry form.
 - d. If you select the Weather-Based Irrigation Controller with Rain Sensor, Center for Resource Conservation staff will replace your existing controller with the new weather-based controller.
 - e. Weather-based Irrigation Controller recipients: Homeowners must agree to sign up for a free Irrigation Inspection, which will be scheduled in the 2011 irrigation season.
- Required at time of toilet pick-up and irrigation product installation: Proof of lawful presence in the United States according to provisions of Colorado Law (Immigration Law, HB 06S-1023). Under the law, anyone 18 years of age or older must prove lawful presence in the United States in order to receive non-emergency public benefits. In order to prove lawful presence in the United States, you must produce a valid driver's license or other valid form of identification and sign an affidavit.
