Daily water use data began rolling out to residential customers in June. Currently, approximately 80% of customers can view daily water use in the <u>WaterSmart</u> portal, receive alerts of high or unusual water usage, and easily manage their account to help save water and money. These features are estimated to be available to all residential customers by <u>December 2025</u> as part of the Advanced Metering Infrastructure (AMI) project.

Already, Thornton Water customers have saved thousands of gallons from continuous use notifications sent from the WaterSmart customer portal.



Water Use Rules for the Summer

Like many municipalities in Colorado, Thornton has specific water use rules for outdoor irrigation from April 1 to October 31. Reducing outdoor water use is one of the easiest ways to decrease your monthly water usage and has the biggest impact on lowering your water bill. Save water and avoid fines by following these water use rules outdoors:

Water your lawn no more than three days per week between 6 p.m. and 10 a.m. Maximize the amount of water absorbed and strengthen the roots of your lawn using a "cycle and soak" method by dividing these times into three cycles spaced an hour apart:

Schedule watering times based on the month of the year and the type of sprinkler system.

All times listed are in minutes and recommended no more than three days per week in the summer. Exceptions apply for new sod, seeding and reseeding lawns, and large properties that require extra watering time. Vegetable and other gardens can be watered as needed. Plan your watering during the coolest parts of the day to minimize evaporation and maximize water retention for your plants.

Thornton Water will notify customers of detected water leaks and water waste from excessive use. Water leaks and waste must be resolved as soon as possible. If more than 10 days have passed after receiving a courtesy notice, penalties can be imposed starting at \$100 for residential customers and \$250 for commercial irrigation offenses


